

Do Dham Yatra — Badrinath & Kedarnath

The two eastern dhams in six days, with the Kedarnath trek on foot

About this trek

The Do Dham is the yatra most people have time for, and it covers the two temples closest to our base at Joshimath. We walk the Kedarnath trail from Gaurikund as a group with a leader, stay the night at Kedarnath for the morning darshan, and drive over to Badrinath through our own valley.

3	Kedarnath to Guptkashi Kedarnath → Gaurikund → Guptkashi Morning darshan and the descent.	16 km · 6 hrs trek + drive · Guptkashi (hotel)
4	Guptkashi to Badrinath Guptkashi → Chopta → Joshimath → Badrinath Drive over Chopta and through Joshimath to Badrinath; evening aarti.	190 km · 8 hrs drive · Badrinath (hotel) · 10,170 ft
5	Badrinath, Mana, drive to Rudraprayag Badrinath → Mana → Rudraprayag Darshan, Tapt Kund and Mana village, then the drive down.	165 km · Morning visit + 7 hrs drive · Rudraprayag (hotel)
6	Rudraprayag to Haridwar Rudraprayag → Haridwar Drive out via Devprayag.	165 km · 6 hrs drive · —
